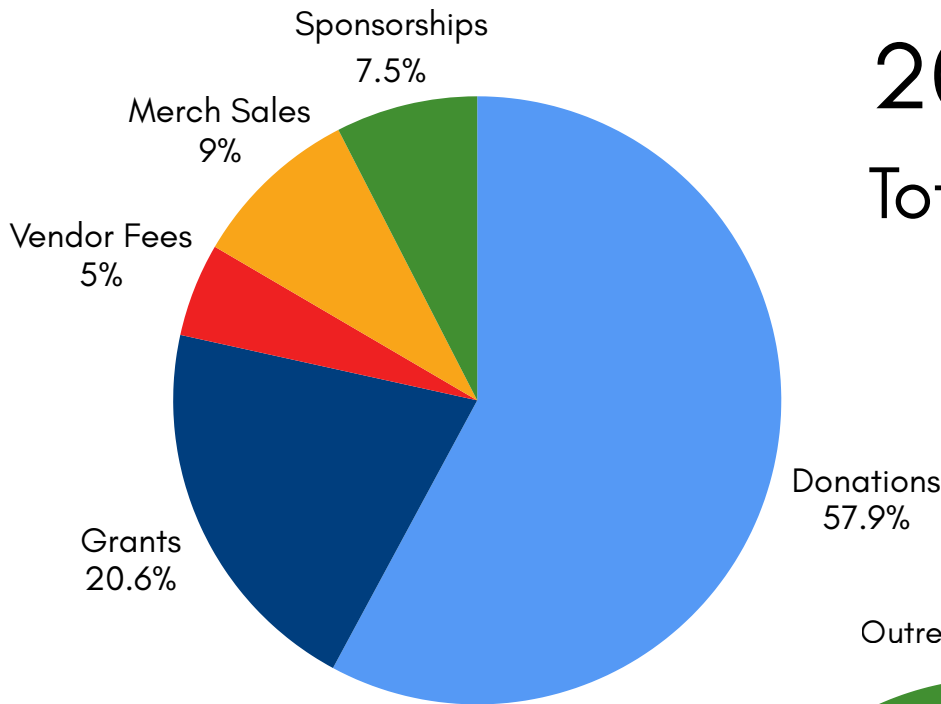

## **STOOD TOGETHER IN SOLIDARITY & LOVE**

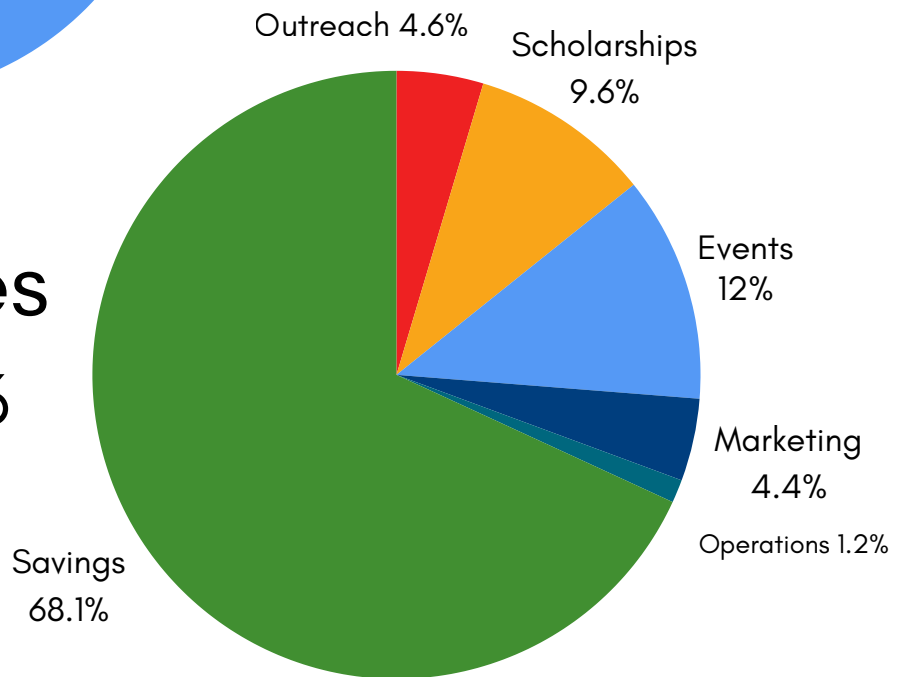
